



## **Pylons in Pontrobert**

### **Write & Fight Day – 29 September 2012**

Dear Pontrobert Resident

Please take time to read this letter- it concerns the future of YOUR countryside.

You will be aware that proposals for multiple wind turbines in the Welsh border hills have resulted in a decision by National Grid to site a new power hub at Cefn Coch and erect a chain of pylons from the hub along the Vyrnwy valley . The proposed corridor for the siting of the pylons has recently been extended to include a route not only passing close to Pontrobert village, but also affecting residents in the surrounding area.

The consultation process so far by National Grid and Scottish Power has already aroused very strong objections, and resulted in the creation of Montgomery Against Pylons (MAP) to spearhead the fight. Local people who attended a meeting on 8<sup>th</sup> August expressed strong views about supporting MAP in their continuing campaign, and a small group of Pontrobert volunteers has met to move things forward.

In order to coordinate local opposition it is proposed to hold a **Write& Fight Day** at Pontrobert village hall on Saturday 29 September between 3 - 8pm, where we can all gather information and share methods of opposing the pylons and turbines, such as supporting MAP, signing petitions and writing to power providers and decision makers. Refreshments will be available.

If you want to make a difference and show that this is our landscape and we care about it, please come on 29<sup>th</sup> September.
